I can multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.

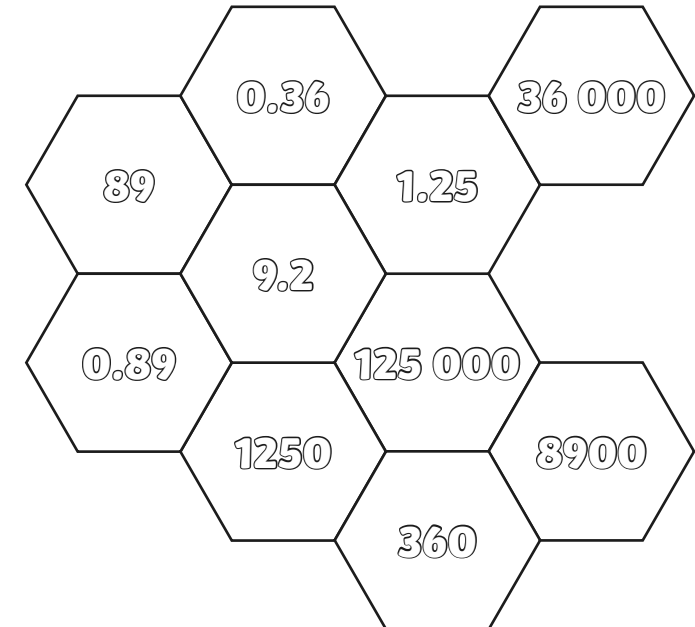
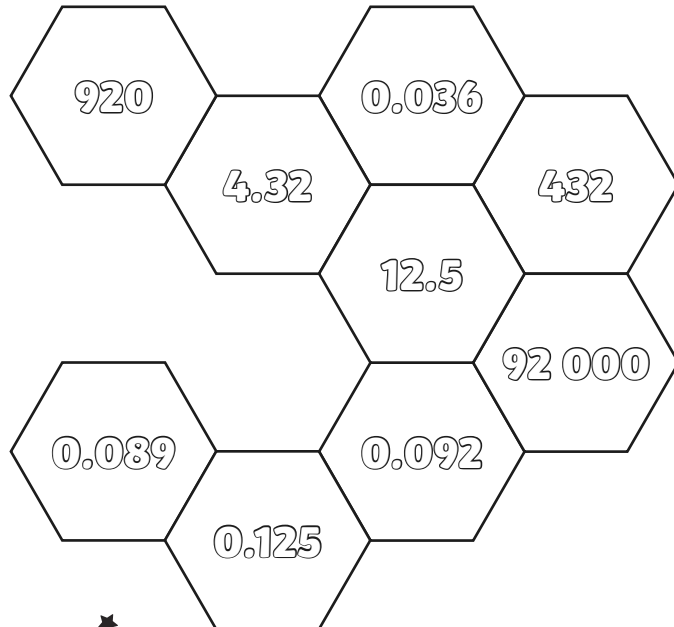


- 1) Choose one of the numbers in the stars.

$\times 10$	$\div 1000$	$\times 1000$	$\div 100$	$\div 10$	$\times 100$





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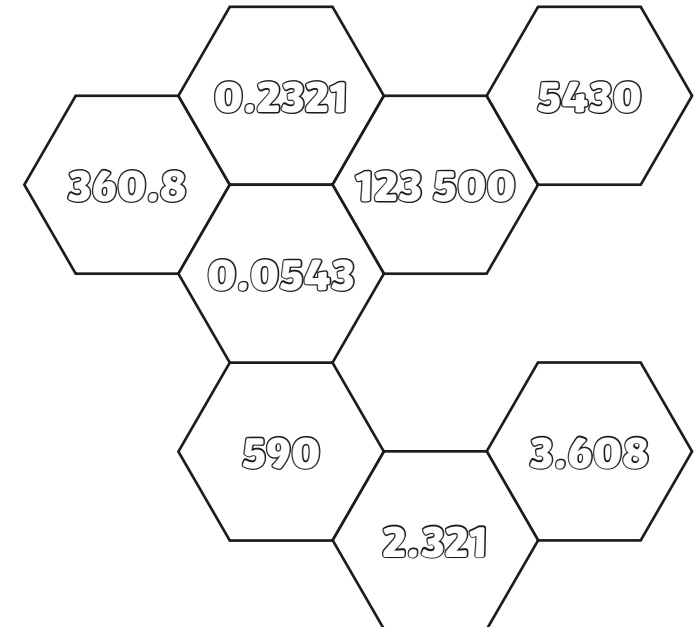
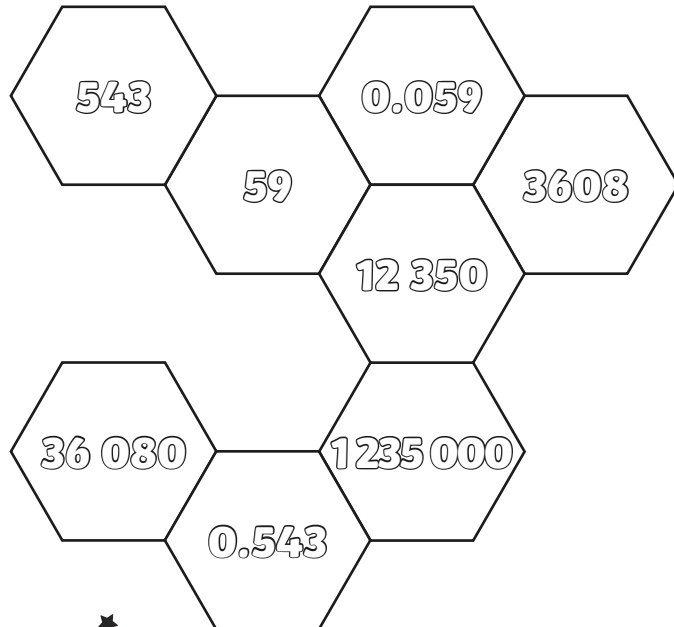


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
