

Maths

The children will be revising number bonds to 10 and 20, and will be recapping on the 2, 5, 10 times tables before moving onto the 3, 4, and 8 time tables.

The children will then be looking at place value of numbers up to 1000 and learn to use the column method for addition and subtraction

The children will be using cubes, base 10 and other manipulatives to explore and compare numbers.

English

Computing

History/Geography
