

## Maths

Children will be looking at decimals, with a focus on tenths and hundredths and understanding the value of these. We will be consolidating the children's understanding of standard written methods.

We are actively encouraging the children to learn their times table facts by heart.

## English

We will be looking at the following texts during our reading into writing sessions.

The Lion and the Unicorn

The Odd and The Frost Giants

We will be answering VIPERS questions on each text as well as writing in different styles for different audiences.

## Art/DT

We are looking at watercolour, including using different techniques in our art work. We are learning about the artist Monet.



## Computing

E safety: We will be looking at using technology safely, responsibly and respectfully and keeping ourselves safe online. We will be continuing to move through the stages of learning coding including how to debug programs.

## History/Geography

We are finding out about Ancient Egypt this term, including a visit from Treehouse Theatre for our Egyptian day. We are going to learn about Pharaohs, mummification, Egyptian geography and lots more.

## Music/French

French: This half term we will be learning about clothes, applying sentence structures that they have learned previously to the clothing vocabulary.

Music: We will be continuing to look at rhythm and graphic notation – playing and writing them.

## Science

This half term we will be learning about Electricity! We will be exploring static electricity, circuit symbols and will be learning how to build our own circuits.

## RE

Our main religion focus this half term is Christianity and forgiveness on the lead up to Easter. We will have a visit from Reverend Partridge to answer questions about forgiveness.

## PSHE

This term we will be focussing on keeping ourselves safe with a focus on rights and responsibilities. We are looking forward to a visit from the Life Van.

## PE

This term, we will be continuing with invasion games looking at handball. Each class will be swimming – Puffin on a Wednesday and Swan on a Friday.
